



AMCIS 2022 Presenter Exception Program (PEP)

As is typical with academic conferences, including 26 years of AMCIS, the requirement of at least one author of every accepted paper is to present the paper onsite. As the world continues to return to 'normal', many people from across the globe may still be unable to attend the conference. AMCIS 2022 is providing a limited number of exceptions on a case-by-case basis if no co-author of a paper can present onsite at the conference. If none of the co-authors is able to present onsite, please follow the below steps:

1. Try identifying a colleague to present the paper on your behalf onsite at the conference
2. For 2022, there is a second option. Authors of a paper could request to have their presentation re-assigned to one of the two hybrid equipped rooms at the conference. AMCIS 2022 has arranged for two paper session rooms to be equipped with hybrid delivery.
